MINUTES LBHA Board of Directors Meeting September 16, 2020

The Board of Directors held a meeting at the arena in Loomis. The following Board members were present: Liz Daffner, Maureen Henderson, Janis Rau, Greg King, Joe Warlow, and Kathy Dombrowski. Laurene Davis, Activity Chair was also present, as was member Tara Gee. Melanie Warlow, Kate Johnson, and Bruce Renfrew were not present.

President, Liz Daffner presided. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Maureen reported on the current status of Hidden Falls. The Final SEIR was released on September 4. There are 4 upcoming meetings, the next 3 all taking place in September. Members are needed to appear, preferably in person. If not, an email has been sent to the membership setting forth the procedures for commenting via Zoom or telephone. We will need a very good turnout for the meeting of the Board of Supervisors which will occur in late October or early November.

The main agenda for the meeting was the upcoming horse shows.

Maureen reported on receiving the promised sponsorship monies from Douglas Ranch Supply. She further reported on the status of Loomis Basin Equine Medical Center, Echo Valley Ranch, High Hand Nursery, Green Acres Nursery, Newcastle Produce and Newcastle Auto Tech.

Joe will contact Auburn Equine for a sponsorship. Janis will check with Patty Neifer re Elk Grove Milling. Kathy has offered to contact Sierra Hay, Vetricin, and Sierra Automotive. Greg will contact Sundowner and Tara agreed to contact Platinum Performance for sponsorships.

Janis reported she has inventoried the ribbons for the show and we are good to go with what we have.

Liz will contact Denise re the purchase of small prizes for first place winners. We need about 30 more prizes.

Liz will be responsible for designing the Ranch Riding Pattern.

Liz suggested we hold off on printing the program until closer to the show so that we can list our Sponsors on the back.

Liz and Kathy will get together to input the class list into the database. Kathy will confirm we have the lower baseball field for the show. Liz will contact 4H groups to try to encourage them to come to the shows.

Maureen will contact the County to obtain Covid19 signs for the show grounds.

Janis will confirm Terry Haney for the show. Lisa will contact Lisa Bradley to see if she needs a steward.

The meeting concluded at 7:25 p.m.






Arena

Please NO TRAILERS or HORSES on the asphalt parking lot. No barrels, poles or other equipment may be used in the arena. Small Orange cones allowed. Trainers must have an Arena Use form submitted annually as well as the proper insurance naming LBHA and Placer County as "Also Insureds." If Insurance is cancelled 2 times or more, the permit is no longer valid. Trainers MUST contact LBHA with the time and number of students that will be in class, 24 hrs before the lesson.
